

## Industrial Visit Report 2023

The First Year students Industrial Visit to Silvassa was planned on the 19th and 20th of May 2023 i.e. Friday and Saturday respectively. There were 217 students from all five departments who were accompanied by 7 faculty members, namely Ms. Grishalda D'souza, Ms. Rekha Ajikumar, Ms. Astrid D'souza, Ms. Eden Fernandes, Mr. Ashok Sapale, Mr. Durgaprasad Khalap and Mr. Faiz Ansari. To add to this, there were also tour guides from '**Ashish Holidays**' who accompanied us for the tour. The meeting point was at St. Francis Institute of Technology at 6:30 pm, after which 3 buses departed for the industrial visits.

Our first stop was at Silent Hill Resort in Palghar where a buffet breakfast was served after which we departed towards our first industry. Man Foods Pvt Ltd Industry was a confectionary production industry and our visit there began with a 20 minute long video presentation in the auditorium room that portrayed all the products made by '**Parle**', their history and the methods of production of those products which included chips, biscuits, etc. After the presentation, the students were escorted to observe the factory, its machinery and the process of production of the Parle G biscuit.

The next industry on the list was '**Navneet Education Ltd.**' wherein the students were divided into groups and taken on a tour around the areas where book covers were printed, a whole factory area where books were created by stapling, stitching and binding methods.

On day two of the IV (Saturday, 20th May) we visited a textile industry wherein students were shown two ways of making cloth: handmade and machine made. A tour was taken through the factory and students noted down their observations.
