## **Department of Information Technology Rules of the Coding Competition**

- 1. The students have freedom to code in languages such as C or Java.(Any one).
- 2. The topics that be studied for this competition are as follows:
  - i. Formatting/Padding of Strings and Numbers.
  - ii. Mathematics logic implementation using programming languages.
  - iii. Minimum technical knowledge about the history and invention of Information Technology along with basic concepts of programming language(such as functions, datatypes etc)
  - iv. Knowledge of Data Structures along with complexity's.
- 3. For Round 1, students will be given 1hr 30 minutes to solve the problems along with test cases.
- 4. From Round 1, 15 groups will be qualified for Round2 depending on the test case results and minimum time required to solve the entire Round1 problems.
- 5. Round 2 will be a rapid fire round for duration of 2hr 15 minutes where amongst each group; only the group leader is allowed to use the buzzer app.
- 6. From Round 2, 8 groups will be qualified for Round3.
- 7. For Round 3, every group will be given one questionnaire (type of mini project) and to complete it they will given 2 hrs. 30 mins of time.
- 8. Carrying of any digital watches, calculators and mobile phones or any other electronic equipment's is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Carrying of any written material or chits should be avoided.
- 10. No participant from any group is allowed to leave the venue until the respective rounds are over.
